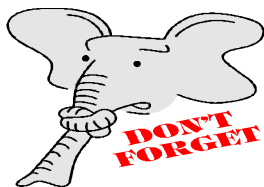

Grenfell Soccer is ready to welcome new and old players to the 2009 season. Our registration days will be held on Thursday 19th March from 4-6pm and Saturday 31st March from 9-12am outside the IGA store. We will also take nominations at the soccer grounds on Wednesday 25th March from 4-5pm. If this is your child's first season you will need to bring proof of their age. If these dates don't suit you can contact Tristen Matthews on 63436207 to leave your name and arrange for a form. Our registration fees are 5-8 years- \$55, 9-17 years - \$65 or Family - \$150. Cheques can be made out to Grenfell Junior Soccer Club Inc. or you can pay cash. There has been a slight change to the age groupings. The teams will be 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 & 17 yrs & under, with the age being the age they turn anytime this year. The minimum age is 5. The first game for the season will be after the holidays, at Young.
